

What can and can't go into a skip bin?



Allowed Waste Types

- ✓ **Mixed Household Waste**
Most general household waste, cardboard, clothes, toys, plastic, metal, light timber.
- ✓ **Mixed Building Waste**
Waste from household or industrial renovations including mixed concrete (dry), bricks, tiles, timber, gyprock, plastic, general building waste.
- ✓ **Furniture**
Including household furniture, tables, chairs, bed bases, sofas and more.
- ✓ **Green Waste**
Organic waste including grass and tree clippings, branches, woodchips, bark and untreated light timber. Tree branches and trunks (up to 300mm in diameter).
- ✓ **Household Appliances**
Including white goods (fridges, washing machines, dryers, etc.) and kitchen goods.
- ✓ **Carpet and underlay**

Waste Types Incurring Additional Costs

- \$ **Mattresses**
- \$ **Gas bottles**
- \$ **Ceramic floor and wall tiles**
- \$ **Tyres**
- \$ **Tree stumps / palm trunks (clean)**
Over 300mm in diameter
- \$ **Pianos or pool tables**
- \$ **Artificial lawn, sports- or playground surfaces**

Prohibited Waste Types

Heavy charges may apply if any of the following items are discovered in your skip bin. L&D Brown Skip Bin Hire reserves the right to refuse pickup.

- ⊗ **Asbestos waste**
Unless in a special asbestos waste bin.
- ⊗ **Oil heaters**
- ⊗ **Fire extinguishers**
- ⊗ **Fibro (compressed or not)**
Including fibro cement sheeting.
- ⊗ **Silica dust**
- ⊗ **Batteries of any kind**
Including car, lithium, electric tool, toy or any other batteries.
- ⊗ **Liquids, chemicals, resin**
Including paint and spray cans
- ⊗ **Food & liquids**
- ⊗ **Medical Waste**
Including needles, syringes, soiled dressings, chemicals, pharmaceuticals, medical devices or radioactive materials
